### 3. Treasurer's Report

#### 4. Club donation

## 5. Travel Co-ordinator report

CB reported that no coaches had run to the Hemel and Dartford fixtures and that there had been a small loss on the Chippenham trip. There have been 33 bookings for the upcoming Bracknell coach.

It was agreed to advertise coaches to Braintree, Dulwich and Slough but not for Chelmsford.

## 6. Tea Bar report

SM reported that a sum of £65 was carried forward from the previous month, takings from the Welling, Bromley, Chippenham and Worthing fixtures totalled £1439 with stock purchases of £505. £360 has recently been banked with £439 taken on SumUp. £200 has been carried forward.

As expected sales have picked up now that winter has arrived and most purchases are now being made by card.
